R-I School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Eight Million Dollars (\$8,000,000) for the purpose of providing funds to renovate the Elementary School, Middle School, Schlup building, and old Riley football field roofs; to replace the Middle School heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) system; to renovate the weight room; to construct, equip, and furnish a new indoor athletic facility; to install new Elementary School playground equipment; to construct, equip, and furnish a CPAC workshop/set design building; to install new flooring; to purchase new High School furnishings; to expand the District security camera system; to alleviate erosion issues around the old Riley football field; to install a new LED sign in front of the High School; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof?</p> <p>If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$1.1835 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO</p>	<p align="center">TIPTON R-6 QUESTION 1</p> <p>Shall the Board of Education of Tipton R-VI School District issue general obligation bonds in the amount of Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000) for the purpose of constructing and equipping a multi-purpose student activities building which will include (1) an indoor turf area for marching band, wrestling, archery, cheerleading, and vocational activities, (2) a weight room for physical education classes and teams, and (3) a full-sized basketball court? <p align="center">CIP TAX RENEWAL</p> <p>Shall the City of Boonville renew and continue to impose the existing tax of one-half of one percent (1/2 %) for capital improvements for the next five (5) years, and to continue waiver of the collection of a license tax for vehicles as required in Section 12-66 of the City ordinances of the City of Boonville for the same period of five (5) years?</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO</p>	<p align="center">Proposition 2 Secure our Future</p> <p>Shall the Board of Education of the Smithton R-VI School District, Missouri, borrow money in the amount of Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000) for the purpose of providing funds to implement safety and security improvements District-wide; to renovate and relocate the existing Elementary school drop off area and playground; to renovate and relocate the preschool; to provide covered areas at the entrance of the elementary and secondary buildings; to convert existing lighting to LED; to resurface parking lots; to renovate ceilings, floors, and walls in classrooms; to replace heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) units; to upgrade sidewalks; to install new turf and landscaping; to the extent funds are available, acquire equipment and complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof resulting in an estimated increase to the debt service property tax levy of \$0.4500 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation?</p> <p>If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to increase from \$0.0000 to \$0.4500 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO</p>	<p align="center">TIPTON R-6 QUESTION 2</p> <p>Shall the Board of Education of the Tipton R-VI School District be authorized to increase the operating tax levy by fifty cents (\$0.50) per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation, such increase to be deposited into the Special Revenue (Teachers') Fund to maintain teacher salaries at a competitive and comparable level to school districts of similar size in Mid-Missouri?</p> <p>If this question is approved, the adjusted operating levy ceiling of the District is estimated to be \$3.4671 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO</p>
<p align="center">Proposition - Teachers</p> <p>Shall the Board of Education of the Otterville R-VI School District, Missouri, be authorized to increase the operating tax levy by \$0.3000 to \$3.9108 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation for the purposes of attracting and retaining quality certified staff? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted operating tax levy of the District is estimated to increase by \$0.3000, from \$3.6108 currently to \$3.9108 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation for the 2025 Tax Year, and can be applied to the assessed valuation for each year thereafter.
